Family Support Committee:

Help out families that are going through life events – birth, death or sickness.

Going Out/School's out activities:

Weekly parent coffee meetings to build community amongst parents.

Mentor families:

Coordinates mentors for new and incoming families. Work directly with Andrea to match existing families with incoming families and provide support to matched families.
